A Message from the Community Spiritual Director -

Dear Emmaus Community,

I hope you experienced the joy of celebrating the Easter event fresh in your hearts, homes, churches and parishes during Lent. The life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ are core beliefs of our faith. We are the modern day disciples or witnesses of the resurrection. The spirit of Christ lives in us, and through us, and we have the awe-some privilege of sharing the love of Christ. We are the Easter people who Christ has called to be his servants!!!

As the spiritual director of the Greater Cincinnati Emmaus community there are times I need to communicate a concern, and issue a big challenge to this community. This letter is one I believe is needed and necessary at this time. It's my hope you will receive it with grace, and respond in love through acts of service.

As you know it takes a huge commitment to host an Emmaus Walk. The majority of that commitment needs to be "behind the scenes or background support." We need more "hands and feet" to support this ongoing ministry. The community is an extension of the live-in team for each walk. The team has a role to play for each walk and the community has a very important role to play. There needs to be an "equal commitment by both" to have a great walk.

This is my concern---We have <u>not been receiving</u> enough "behind the scenes or background support" for recent walks. We need more members of this Emmaus community to support the walks on a regular basis. There are many ways you can serve. Some simple tasks are necessary with little time commitment. Others are very important and need more time commitments. In some cases like table agape--that means pre-walk commitment. In other cases it means financial agape--for Thursday desserts, soft

drinks/candy for the weekend, ice cream social, and Sunday carnations on women's walks.

Lastly, there needs to be more "community prayer support." This can be done by signing up for 30minutes or 1-hour time slots. Come on site for a few hours, a half of a day, or all day, and pray anonymously in the prayer chapel. You can come alone or invite your share group to spend that time in prayer with you on a walk. We need a greater commitment from this community to be intentional in under girding the walks with prayer. It's a privilege to be in prayer for the pilgrims. This task should not be left alone to a few, but for many in the broader ecumenical community.

The challenge is before you as the community. <u>How will</u> <u>you respond through acts of service and stronger commitment?</u> You can sign up for the jobs or prayer vigil at gatherings and candlelight's. I'm challenging you to respond in love to serve "behind the scenes or as background support" for future walks. Without this renewed commitment the quality of the walks and the experience for the pilgrims may be less. I have tremendous faith in this loving and caring community. May all your 4th days continued be blessed in serving the risen Lord!!! Christ is Counting on You!
